that its inhabitants would band together and fight, if need be, to the death, to preserve the blessing of the land and its contents;

That those discovered boundaries include the point at which the Northern Pole of the Earth begins,

And the opposite Southern Pole of the Earth;

THE WEST POLE

As there are recognized and generally accepted North and South Poles on Planet Earth, there too must be East and West Poles. This being Texas, the 98th Meridian is universally recognized as "Where The West Begins," located right here--Deep in the Heart of Texas--we have little use and even less concern for an "East" Pole.

Until now, having never enjoyed an organized expedition to discover the "West Pole" such as Admiral Byrd and his Antarctic explorers, the task befell a group of patriotic Sons of Texas--the *Lone Star Meteorological Society*--to discover, appropriately recognize and publicly designate the site of the actual West Pole.

This location, at 30 degrees, 18.25' North and 97 degrees, 56.28' West, Bee Cave, Texas, is therefore designated **The West Pole**, and this plaque hereinafter marks the exact point of The West Pole, as officially recognized by The State of Texas, 79th Legislature, House Resolution 2935, May 28, 2007
